Step 1 – Direct Golfer to Course Page

Have the golfer navigate to your dedicated section on the Dash3 website. The most effective way to do this is by providing a direct link or a QR code for quick access. You can find your QR codes in your **Marketing** in Dash3.

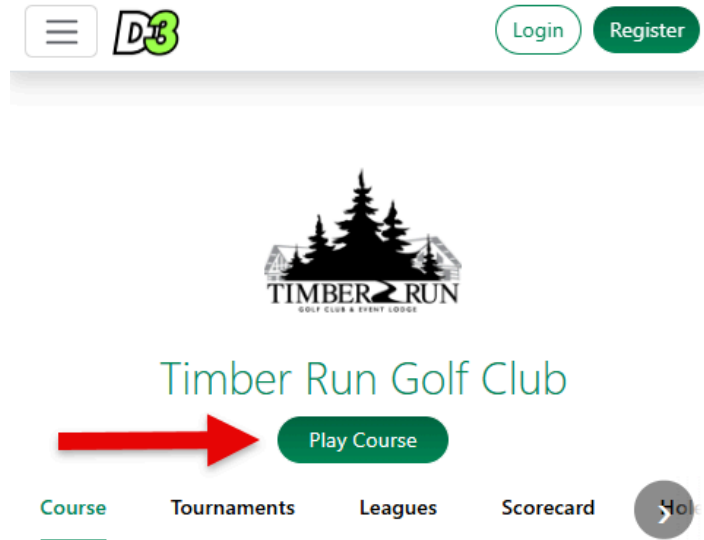

Step 2 – Start Round

Once logged in, navigate to your course page and select “Play Course” to begin your round. This will launch the live scoring feature.

Step 3 – Set Up Your Round

Enter your round details by selecting the round type, tee, number of holes, and scoring format. At minimum, ensure the tee and hole selection are set correctly, then proceed to start the round.

Leaderboards

Select the scoring formats you'd like to include in your round:

- **Gross Strokes:** Standard scoring (most commonly used)
- **Skins / Stableford:** Add alternative formats for more competitive or fun gameplay
- **Net Scoring Options:** Enable if handicaps are being used

You can select one or multiple leaderboard formats depending on how you want to run your round.

Once round is started, you will be provided with a link and QR code to invite others to join your round.

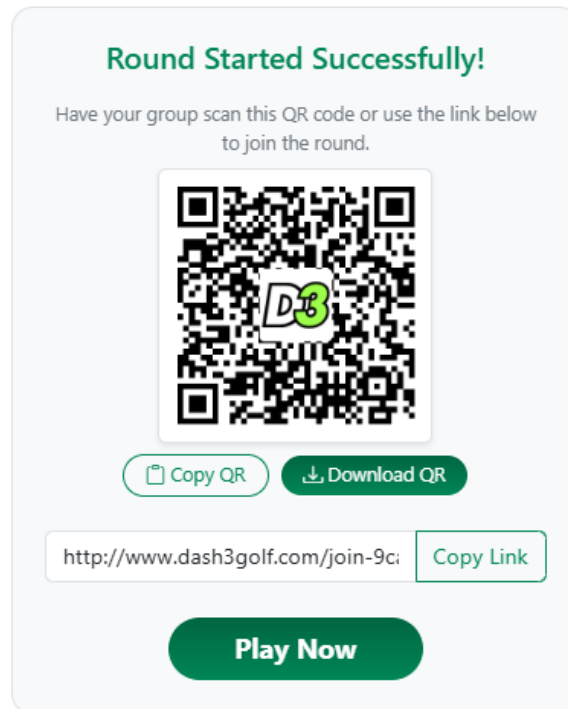
